Lakes Region League Winter Interscholastic Guidelines

As we prepare to transition to the winter athletic season, the Lakes Region League Schools continue to collaborate to provide the safest interscholastic experience possible, evolving policies given the nature of the winter season and the landscape of schools we compete against.

Our revised guidelines are as follows:

Teams

- Will compete with schools whose (9-12, PG) student body is at least 90% vaccinated
- Lakes Region Schools may ask for vaccination status of individual teams
- Lakes Region League Schools may ask for positivity rates in opponent schools or communities as a secondary measure to determine comfort level with competition
- Opponents must test unvaccinated athletes weekly for COVID-19 and results must be shared in advance of games
- Lakes Region League athletes who have a religious or medical exemption from vaccination are required to test weekly for COVID-19 to be eligible to participate

Spectators

- All spectators should be vaccinated
- Spectators, whether internal community members or outside guests, are required to be masked at all indoor venues
- Only coaches and athletes competing in the game may be unmasked
- Individual schools may set capacity limits for their facilities. Please check school websites prior to attending competitions
