



# BREWSTER ACADEMY SUMMER ENRICHMENT PROGRAM

## BASIC INFORMATION

- The Brewster Academy Summer Enrichment Program (SEP), is a free online experience for current and incoming Brewster students.
- Students select a program via a simple online application.
- All courses are taught by experienced faculty.

## DATES AND FEES

- July 6–31, 2020
- Courses are **free** for all returning and new Brewster students.
- The test preparation course has a \$50 material fee and optional fees for one-on-one instruction.

## PROGRAM DESIGN

- Students may take up to three online courses.
- Each course will be managed through a combination of asynchronous lessons and one-hour synchronous classes.

## COURSE OFFERINGS

- Welcome to Brewster (9th grade): Two options, one language-focused based on *The Absolutely True Diary of a Part-Time Indian* by Sherman

Alexie, and the other history-focused based on *The Alchemist* by Paulo Coelho.

- Introduction to Spanish I
- Introduction to French I
- Crazy Mandarin (language and cultural reflections)
- Writing the College Essay (for rising seniors)
- Chemistry at a Glance
- Physics at a Glance
- Introduction to Precalculus
- The Hamilton Education Project (learn how Lin-Manuel Miranda got the inspiration for the hit Broadway musical *Hamilton* and create your own Hamilton-style performance)
- Science in Art
- Modern Media Studies (exploring ways modern media has changed and how it has changed us)
- The Short Story
- Theater Mosaic
- Experiential Anatomy (using yoga to learn about how the muscles, joints, and fascia work together to move the body)
- The Magic of Sketchbook (drawing, doodling, and finding your creative and visual storytelling style)

## COLLEGE PREP OFFERINGS

- Knower Academics, Brewster's longtime partner, will be offering a test prep workshop during Summer Enrichment Classes.
- Students meet synchronously in Knower's Zoom classroom for one hour a day on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from July 6 to July 31.
- Great way to stay connected with friends, keep learning strong, and maintain focus on college applications.
- There is no course fee for Brewster students. Students will only be required to pay for their books and materials (\$50).
- As part of the class registration, families who are interested in more intensive one-to-one test prep can also purchase packages of sessions to work on specific math, grammar, and reading skills needed to review for the SAT and ACT.
