- Summer temperatures typically between 70-85 F (21-29 C)

Program Design

- Focus on skills
- Small class sizes
- Courses in the morning (weekdays) include choice of:

STEM Courses, such as Computer Graphics, CSI: Crime Scene Investigation, Digital Photography, Drone Technology, Movie Making, Rockets: The Geometry Behind NASA, Web Design, 3D Modeling and 3D Printing

Humanities Courses, such as: Creative Writing, English as a Second Language (ESL), English Literature, One-Act Theater, Media Studies & Modern Expression

Other Courses, such as: Designing Your Academic Life

- Adventure recreation and afternoon activities include art, hiking, canoeing, kayaking, rock climbing, initiative activities and sports
- Weekends include cultural and fun activities
